EQUIPMENT CLOSET

CPATH’s Equipment Closet Program is designed to exchange and reuse pediatric durable medical equipment to anyone in need, at no cost. We want to ensure that every person has access to equipment that will meet their needs. Wheelchairs, walkers, standers, car seats, or adaptive bikes... **CPATH is here to help. Impact since March 2019:**

Items donated to CPATH: 457 items with a value of \$674,991.00
Items distributed to the community: 372 (81%) with a value of \$612,694 (91%)



GRANTS

CPATH’s Grant Program is available year-round to provide financial assistance for families, caregivers, and individuals living with cerebral palsy. The program includes access to funds for items such as equipment, therapies, camps, recreation, and educational workshops.

CPATH has provided 46 Grants since 2013 TOTALING \$20,812



CAMP CPALS

Camp CPals is an adaptive overnight weekend family camp. The accessible facilities make it possible for all ability levels to participate in every activity! Campers gain confidence, learn new skills, and build relationships in a safe, fun, and adaptive environment - an experience unlike any other. **ALL kids should experience outdoor activities — without barriers!**

CPATH hosted 63 campers and 23 volunteers at our 4th Annual Camp CPals in May 2019. We have surpassed over 200 campers since 2016.
